The Post Graduate Foundation in Veterinary Science exists under the Senate of The University of Sydney. It is subject to a set of Rules pursuant to section 37 (1) of The University of Sydney Act 1989 (as amended) and Rule 5 (1) of The University of Sydney By Law 1999 (as amended).

The Post Graduate Foundation works as a centre for continuing veterinary education externally funded by its registered membership. It is thus, and has been for over 40 years, a major link between the veterinary profession and research-generated knowledge from the world's most respected institutions.

As well, the Foundation through various means has supported numerous specific academic projects mostly within the Faculty of Veterinary Science at The University of Sydney.

The Foundation came about in 1965 due to the efforts of a diverse and forward-thinking group of Australian veterinarians. It was recognised at that early stage that graduate veterinarians needed to have easy access to new knowledge as it became available through the endeavours of researchers and leading clinicians across all fields of veterinary science.

# president's report

2007 has been a year of change for the PGF. As mentioned in the last report, the PGF was required to review its position within The University of Sydney and as a consequence of internal restructuring within The University we had to relinquish our existing Constitution and replace this with a new set of Rules.

Despite finalising the new Rules by the middle of the year, it took until late November 2007 for the Rules to be adopted by the Senate of the University. One of the reasons for this change was that our organisation did not fit into the University legal definition of a Foundation, which is primarily a fund-raising body. In fact, for years we have effectively operated as a Centre, as defined by The University, so for the sake of consistency it was decided we should operate under the rules common to all of The University Centres. This change should have been straightforward, but due to the unique nature of the PGF none of the existing rules fitted our organisation, so we had to negotiate new rules carefully to ensure that all of the traditions, services and benefits of membership of the PGF would be retained.

The Council believed that the final version of the Rules satisfied our requirements and safeguarded the PGF assets and future operations. For those interested, the new Rules can be viewed on the PGF website.

One of the likely outcomes resulting from these changes is that the PGF name may be updated in time to reflect the true nature of the services we provide.

Sadly, during the year one of the founding fathers and the inaugural long term Director of the PGF, Tom Hungerford, died. Much has



been written and published about Tom since his death and I do not intend to repeat that here. However, I believe Tom's legacy to the veterinary profession, apart from his prolific authorship of so many books, is the establishment of the PGF. He mentored the Directors who were his successors and left an indelible mark on the ideals and values of the PGF. His 'goanna track to success' has been a model for many successful veterinary enterprises and fittingly the goanna has become the emblem of the PGF, as a lasting recognition of Tom's involvement and perseverance.

Another major change in 2007 has been the departure of our Director, Michele Cotton. Michele's contract expired in November and Michele did not reapply for the position. Michele has had a long association with the PGF having worked as Deputy Director with Bill Howey, then as Acting Director after Bill's resignation before being appointed as the Director, a position she has held for nearly six years. During that time Michele attended many PGF Courses and workshops and also promoted the PGF widely in the veterinary community. She worked tirelessly to improve the staffing structure at the PGF and instigated many workplace and fiscal policies to stabilise the organisation and set things on an even keel after some difficult financial periods. On behalf of the Council, the staff and all of the PGF membership I would like to acknowledge Michele's contribution to the PGF and wish her well in her future pursuits.

# president's report

During the period from Michele's departure to the end of the year, the PGF team has been lead by the extremely capable Patricia Swift, who stepped up from Deputy Director to Acting Director, and will remain in that role until a new Director is appointed. Patricia is an excellent administrator and an educator, who has brought new energy and insight into the operation of our organisation. Patricia should also be thanked for her hard work and commitment during a difficult time.

Financially, 2007 was a reasonable year for the PGF. We managed to make a small profit, but an analysis of the performance of the various cost centres showed that Courses was the one area which failed to break even or make money. This was possibly a result of the impact made by the World Small Animal Veterinary Association Conference held in Sydney in August which attracted huge support and attendance and therefore competed with the PGF course offering. It may also be due to the changing nature of our profession, so we need to review the requirements of our members and make sure we are offering interesting courses with a content and duration that is attractive.

Finally, I would like to thank the Council members and the staff at the PGF for their ongoing commitment and I am sure that 2008 will be a wonderful year.

# director's report

## The Year 2007

2007 was a year of change for the Post Graduate Foundation (PGF) in many ways. There was a number of staff changes that took corporate knowledge out of the PGF which we strived to fill. Staff left to take up new opportunities and we had a number take maternity leave. In September Michele Cotton went on leave prior to her departure as Director. Her efforts in putting the PGF in a sound financial position have allowed the PGF to continue its service to the veterinary community and to look to the future of continuing professional development.

The reviews and restructure of The University of Sydney that started in 2006 continued in 2007 and saw the PGF approved as a 'Centre of The University of Sydney' which was ratified by The University Senate on 4th December 2007. While this will not impact on the PGF services to its membership it does give us a clear reporting line which has been lacking over the last few years.

The PGF also started on a major Information Technology and Communication project that will culminate in 2008 with a new website which increases the functionality and usability of our site. This also includes the development of a PGF e-library which will allow our members to search all of our publications on the web. This project was well underway at the end of 2007.

Sadly 2007 also saw the passing away of our founding Director. Tom Hungerford's life was celebrated by the PGF by dedicating the December 2007 Director's Circular and the C&T to him.

# director's report

The 2007 course numbers that were full were high, however we may see a reduction in 2008 participants due to the equine influenza virus which has had a massive impact on all sectors within the equine market, large animal practices, mixed practices and the continuing drought affecting demand for the Ruminant Nutrition course.

## Workshops

Were well received with good feedback from participants to staff attending the workshops. They are an integral part of the course structure which participants enjoy immensely.

What may have to be taken into consideration to expand our DE offerings overseas, is that overseas participants often cannot attend any workshops due to the distance and costs involved.

## Module 0

Development and distribution took longer than anticipated, however all module zeros were delivered and WebCT set up to accept them with the minimum of disruption.

## TimeOnline

2007 was the first full year of the Post Graduate Foundation's TimeOnline program, with four courses being run. Each course was delivered completely online, via The University of Sydney's e-learning system, WebCT; and ran for six weeks. The participants were able to download notes, complete quizzes, join in discussion forums, and view videos and images, at a time convenient to them from their own home or practice.

The year started in February with Arthritis; this course was tutored by Adam Toyer. Sixty people participated, 49 of those being PGF members.

In May we had David Blyde tutor the (Australian) Wildlife course, with a total of 69 participants, including one from South Africa.

August saw the Arthritis course run again; this time just 29 people enrolled.

Then the year finished off with Alex Rosenwax tutoring the Avian course which had 67 people participate, including seven from overseas.

The TimeOnline program has been well received with some people enrolled in more than one course, and also registering interest in courses yet to be developed.

Participants of all courses have not just enjoyed the course content, but also the opportunity to communicate or catch up with each other, through the discussion forums.

The TimeOnline program continues to develop with a number of new tutors working on courses for delivery in 2008/2009.

## Publications

The Control & Therapy series and the Perspectives in 2007 underwent a number of changes to formatting and timing. Bringing these publications to press is a highly consultative process. Tracking down articles and photographs that fit with each article is a demanding task. We were very fortunate in tracking down a picture of Dr Hungerford (with his wife Roslyn) holding his books, in particular his *Diseases of Livestock* to grace the front of our Tom Hungerford Memorial Issue.

Due to economy of scale, the cost of buying extra copies of the C&T/Perspective and Director's Circular is cheaper the more copies are printed. With this in mind, and because the content and layout of the March issue was so good, we printed additional copies to be sent to all New Zealand Vets to show them what they were missing – the C&T/Perspective series being unique and not matched by anything in NZ. The timing was excellent, as it tied in with our NZ course Pure 100% Medicine held in Auckland in October.

In order to achieve our twin goals of 'growing' the series and also of staying within budget we instigated cost-saving measures to provide for the costs of these publications. This was achieved by changing the printing and postage providers.

In October 2006 Richard Malik suggested we contact Dr David Simpson BVSc, MVetClinStud, FACVSc from The Animal Referral Hospital, Strathfield, to ask him if:

- (a) he would grant permission for us to republish his Neurology and Neurosurgery 2004 TimeOut Notes as a Perspective, and
- (b) if he was amenable, if he would consider updating the notes and adding visuals in order to maximise the facility to print in colour.

Not only did David generously agree to undertake this task, he indicated he would 'relish the opportunity to update and improve the text, as well as adding as many photos, radiographs, MRI, CT etc images as we could take.' David took on this onerous task with no financial recompense other than our offer to supply him with 50 copies of the Perspective. The result is a stunning 80 page stand-alone Perspective which accompanied our June Control & Therapy issue.

The great benefit of republishing these notes is not only that they are revised, updated and include colour pictures, greatly enhancing their value, but they are sent out to every financial PGF supporter, not just those few who attended the course.

## Website 2007

In 2007 website usage grew significantly with a steady increase in visitors logging into the PGF site each month.

Over 300 more members were granted access to the member-only pages of the website, bringing those now registered to 3777.

# Valentine Charlton

## research report

The Valentine Charlton Bequest supports Richard Malik's fractional position with the PGF. In the spirit of the bequest, Richard devotes a substantial component of his time to creating new knowledge in relation to feline medicine, and disseminating new information pertinent to feline practice and the welfare of cats generally. In addition to this, Richard has maintained his passion for infectious diseases, publishing actively in this area in relation to dogs and wildlife, as well as cats.

There were many publication highlights during the year, including:

- development and application of a panfungal PCR to detect and identify fungi in fresh and formalin fixed tissue specimens (in a collaborative project driven by Dr Catriona Halliday at Westmead Hospital)
- the largest case series of dogs with protothecosis, a life-threatening algal infection (with Dr Vicki Stenner and a large group of colleagues)
- the largest prospective survey of FIV infection undertaken in Australia (with Dr Jacqui Norris and her team from the University of Sydney)
- the first case of EF-4a infection to be successfully treated in a cat (with Drs Melissa Catt and Randolph Baral from Paddington Cat Hospital)
- a preliminary report of invasive mycotic rhinitis in cats due to *Aspergillus* and closely related fungi (with Dr Vanessa Barrs and colleagues)
- a provocative personal perspective of how cats should be fed for health and longevity (published in *The Veterinarian*)
- a widely publicised report of cocaine intoxication in a cat (with Drs Dominic Barfield and Sally Pegrum)

- an opinionated 'think piece' on the pathophysiology of intraoral eosinophilic granulomas and their management
- numerous other case studies, 'what is your diagnosis?' features and several invited editorials and letters to editors.

Richard has continued to co-supervise Drs Elissa Kluger, Joanna White and Mr Nathan Saul in their doctoral studies of lipid metabolism, feline renal disease and cryptococcosis respectively. Many papers from these students are in the pipeline! Collaborative studies of mycobacteria with Drs Caroline O'Brien, Janet Fyfe, and Mr Tarrant Hansen are ongoing, while cryptococcosis remains a fascinating focus of multi-disciplinary research with a wide variety of colleagues including Dr Mark Krockenberger, and Associate Professors Wieland Meyer and Dee Cater.

In relation to the Foundation, Richard contributes to selection of speakers, especially new speakers. He helps edit the Control & Therapy and Perspective series. He assists in delivery of Feline Distance Education, and in advising the Director in relation to trends in small animal practice. By presenting and attending conferences overseas, he can advise the Foundation about new trends in continuing veterinary education, so we can take the best ideas from North America and Europe and adapt them to an Australian setting. In the same way, by assisting colleagues in a number of small animal practices (including the RSPCA), he can provide feedback to the Foundation about what general practitioners need and want in relation to their life-long learning needs.

Finally, Richard had the privilege of being invited to present a series of lectures at Cornell University together with Kenny Simpson, Ray Dillon and Steve DiBartola.


