**Dr Peter Bennett** BVSc FACVSc DipACVIM

Dr Peter Bennett graduated from the University of Melbourne in 1981 and spent some years in small animal practice in Melbourne and the United Kingdom. He then trained in small animal internal medicine at Massey University, Universities of Tennessee and Georgia, and the University of Melbourne. He obtained his fellowship in canine medicine from the Australian College of Veterinary Scientists and diplomate status in small animal internal medicine from the American College of Veterinary Internal Medicine. Peter returned to the United States where he was a clinical instructor in oncology at Purdue University for three years. In 2001 he obtained diplomate status in oncology from the American College.

On completion of the instructorship, Peter returned to Melbourne where he is currently working at the Melbourne Veterinary Specialist Centre. Peter has been involved in undergraduate and post-graduate training in both oncology and internal medicine in both the United States and Australia.
